Footprint Painting

MATERIALS REQUIRED

- Large roll of paper or plain paper taped together (tape the underneath side to join the sheets together)
- Trays of paint. If you don't have paint trays, you can always use paper plates.
- Kitchen roll and water to clean off messy feet!

HOW TO

Footprint painting is another great sensory activity. If you would prefer not to have little painted footprints in the house, then it might be a cleaner option to do this activity outside. Just put some refuse bags down on the ground and roll the paper out over it. You could try to create a scene (e.g. paint some circles and then get the children to make footprint petals around them), or just let them go freeform. Again, be as creative as you like!
