

Name of Lesson/Programme:

Shapes Stamping

Section: 9 Arts & Crafts Activities

Lesson: 15

Purpose: For your child to complete a general art activity.



***NB:** When using paint and materials, children must be supervised at all times.

Materials required:

1. Various colours of paint.
2. A sheet of paper.
3. Kitchen paper tubes.
4. A tray.

How to:

Make sure your child is sitting near or opposite you.

1. To begin you'll need to set up the materials. Using the kitchen roll tubes, create different shapes, such as stars, triangles, rectangles, circles etc.
2. Add a few different colours to a tray dip the top of tubes in paint
3. Stamp the tube onto the paper leaving an impression of the shape you chose. You can do this a few times.
4. Move onto the next shape and repeat the process.
5. Having used all the different shapes you'll be left with a sheet painted in different shapes.
6. Allow to dry and display.
