

Name of Lesson/Programme:

Stencil Painting

Section: Section 9 Arts and Crafts **Lesson:** 12

Purpose: For your child to complete an art activity using paints and a stencil.



*NB: When using paint and materials, children must be supervised at all times.

Materials required:

- 1. A sheet of white paper
- 2. Long strips of cardboard or hard card
- 3. Various colours of paint
- 4. A paintbrush

How to:

Make sure your child is sitting near or opposite you.

- 1. To begin cut out some long and narrow strips of cardboard or hard card.
- 2. Place the strips of cardboard or hard card on top of your page to make a pattern.
- 3. Taking the paintbrush paint over a section of white paper. This can be done repeatedly with various colours until the sheet of white paper has been fully painted over.
- 4. Next you can remove the cardboard or hard card from your sheet of paper leaving a pattern underneath.
- 5. Allow the paint to dry and display.
