

Name of Lesson/Programme:

Sugar/Salt Painting.

Section: Section 9 art and craft **Lesson:** 9

Purpose: For your child to complete an art activity using sugar/ salt.



*NB: When using glue and materials, children must be supervised at all times.

Materials required:

- 1. Sugar/salt
- 2. Food colouring (Different colours if possible)
- 3. Glue
- 4. Bowls
- 5. 1 sheet of paper.
- 6. Spoons

How to:

Make sure your child is sitting near or opposite you.

- Begin by putting some sugar/ salt into a few bowls, depending on how many
 different food colours you have available. Add the food colouring and using a spoon
 mix the sugar/ salt until its changed colour. This can be done by the child
 independently or with a least to most prompt. You can add more food colouring to
 adjust the mixture if necessary.
- 2. With the sheet of paper you can draw a few designs on the page.
- 3. Next you'll cover the designs with the glue.
- 4. After the designs have been covered with glue you can cover them with the various colours of dyed sugar/ salt to your liking.
- 5. Allow the painting to dry and then you can add the child's name and date the art project.
