

## Name of Lesson/Programme:

Cotton bud painting

**Section:** Section 9 Arts and Crafts **Lesson:** 11

**Purpose**: For your child to complete an art activity using cotton buds improving listening skills and fine motor skills.



\*NB: When using paint and materials, children must be supervised at all times.

## Materials required:

- 1. A sheet of paper
- 2. Coloured paints
- 3. Cotton buds
- 4. An elastic band
- 5. A plate or bowl

## How to:

Make sure your child is sitting near or opposite you.

- 1. To begin you'll need to get a number of cotton buds and arrange them into a group and tie them together using a piece of elastic band.
- 2. Next add a few different colours onto a plate or in a bowl.
- 3. Place a sheet of white paper on the table and dip the group of cotton buds into one of the colours and place it on top of the page making a pattern.
- 4. If desired you can make a tree using a black marker, creating its trunk and branches and use the cotton buds to create a pattern of leaves.
