

**Name of Lesson/Programme:**

Fireworks painting

**Section:** 9 Art and craft

**Lesson:** 3

**Purpose:** For your child to complete an art activity and increase their listening and fine motor skills.

**\*MAKE SURE YOUR CHILD IS SUPERVISED DURING THIS ACTIVITY\***



**Materials Required:**

1. 1 sheet of paper
2. Paint (Different colours if possible)
3. Toilet roll inserts (Number will depend on amount of paint colours available)
4. Paper plates or large bowl

## How to:

You will need the child to sit next to or directly across from you.

1. Take the toilet roll inserts and cut about half way into the insert and repeat until you are left with small sections all the way around. See picture above. **\*ADULTS ONLY\***
2. Pour out a small amount of paint onto the paper plate or bowls.
3. Push the toilet roll insert right down into the paint and make sure all the sections are in the paint.
4. Next put it down on the paper and you should be left with a fire work effect.
5. Repeat step 3 and 4 if you're using different coloured paints
