

Name of Lesson/Programme:

Fireworks painting

Section: 9 Art and craft **Lesson**: 3

Purpose: For your child to complete an art activity and increase their listening and fine motor skills.

MAKE SURE YOUR CHILD IS SUPERVISED DURING THIS ACTIVITY



Materials Required:

- 1. 1 sheet of paper
- 2. Paint (Different colours if possible)
- 3. Toilet roll inserts (Number will depend on amount of paint colours available)
- 4. Paper plates or large bowl

How to:

You will need the child to sit next to or directly across from you.

- 1. Take the toilet roll inserts and cut about half way into the insert and repeat until you are left with small sections all the way around. See picture above. *ADULTS ONLY*
- 2. Pour out a small amount of paint onto the paper plate or bowls.
- 3. Push the toilet roll insert right down into the paint and make sure all the sections are in the paint.
- 4. Next put it down on the paper and you should be left with a fire work effect.
- 5. Repeat step 3 and 4 if you're using different coloured paints
